## Re Air Raid Precaution:-

The Chairman of Little Bealings Parish Council then addressed the meeting stating that in view of the present chaos which exists I thought it would be a good idea to obtain first-hand information and have approach Col. Meadows, who has kindly consented to come over and enlighten us.

The talk given by Col Meadows on Air Raid Precaution was as follows:-

The speaker started by generally outlining the scheme of which the main points were

- (1) To utilise the best possible place and improvise for general equipment
- (2) People to run the Post:
  - The Red Cross have arranged to lecture to all Women's Institutes
- (3) Despatch Riders Col Meadows suggested that the older school-children should be trained in this cause

The following Questions and Answers were raised and given:-

- (a) What is our subcentre?
  Witnesham at present, owing to lack of life in Woodbridge
- (b) How to obtain Gas Masks?

  These are distributed to member of Government School, who will circulate them to various centres
- (c) What is cost of protective clothing and of what does it consist? Consists of an oilskin outfit with rubber boots.

A vote of thanks was accorded to Col Meadows for clearing up all of these points.
